Republicans in Congress are trying to pass a bill that would give massive tax breaks for the ultra rich while gutting environmental protections, clean energy investments and laws that are helping drive us toward a more affordable, cleaner future. What does Trump's Big Beautiful Bill mean for Michigan?



Skyrocketing Energy Bills

Spike Michigan household energy costs by **\$110 in 2026, and up to \$290 more annually by 2035.**

Balloon Michigan households' average energy costs by **\$140–\$220 per year** by 2040.



Lost Jobs

Slash \$17.2 billion in Michigan clean energy investments and kill 90,000 Michigan jobs.

Slam the brakes on Michigan's leadership on **battery, EV, clean steel, and solar sectors.**



Massive Corporate Giveaways and Threats to our Democracy

\$10 million "pay-to-play" loophole allowing fossil fuel companies to pay to skip environmental review and approvals of dangerous projects.

10-year ban on state regulation of Artificial Intelligence (AI), preventing critical oversight of AI risks in key sectors (energy, environment, national security, democracy).

Court immunity for government officials – blocking courts from holding officials in contempt, effectively granting a "get out of jail free" card Trump could exploit to subvert lawful court orders.



More Pollution and Health Risks

Emit 1 billion tons more climate pollution annually by 2035.

Push for more expensive and dirty fossil fuels that **drive up local air and water pollution, especially in low-income communities.**



Transportation Cost Increases

Increase gas prices **~37¢/gallon**, adding **\$200+/year** for Michigan drivers.

Punish electric vehicles with a **\$7,500 tax penalty** and new **\$250/year fee**, threatening Michigan's EV industry and hurting local car buyers.
